Lexington Choral Society in concert on April 23

The Lexington County Choral Society Spring concert will be held in the Sanctuary of the St. Andrews Presbyterian Church in Irmo on St. Andrews Road at 7:30 p.m., Friday, April 23, and Saturday, April 24. The concert will feature Brad Beaton and his son on Bagpipes, Larry Shackley of Columbia International University as solo pianist with arrangements of his newly published solos for the Christian Jazz Pianist and also Shackley's newly published choral arrangement of "Good News! The Chariot's Comin'!" He has dedicated this piece to the Lexington County Choral Society and its Director, Harold G. McIntosh. McIntosh said the Choral Society is honored to be performing the world premier of this anthem. The Lexington County Choral Society is completing its third year and has grown to 100+ singers in the group. On this concert there will be 95 members singing. In the Fall of 1998 the society held its first High School Vocal Scholarship Auditions and awarded three vocal scholarships to Lexington County High School students between the ninth and 11th grades. In the fall the Choral Society featured a high school student conductor on the Christmas Concert. The 1998 H. T. Lorick/LCCS Vocal Scholarship winners were: Thomas Steele, Gilbert High School; Richard Brueck, Gilbert High School; and Victoria Wilson, Lexington High School. The 1998-99 Student Conductor was Scott Melton at student at Brookland-Cayce High School. The program features some of the best in sacred, spiritual, Broadway, and folk choral music.
